

**FAQs about eSkills**  
**(Textbook for Computer Science)**

**Class Prep**

**Q. 1. Is there any notebook for Class Prep?**

**Ans.** No, there is no need of notebooks at this level.

**Q. 2. Is it necessary to complete all worksheets given in resources?**

**Ans.** Yes, it is necessary to complete all worksheets given in resources.

**Q. 3. Is it necessary to perform all practical tasks?**

**Ans.** Yes, it is necessary to perform all practical tasks to deliver the proper concept.

**Q. 4. How Computer Science subject will be assessed at Prep level?**

**Ans.** Computer Science is a Graded Subject for Class Prep. It will be graded on the basis of Practical at each Checkpoint.

**Class I – III**

**Q. 1. Is there any notebook for class I-III?**

**Ans.** No need of notebooks at this level, because resource material is fulfilling the requirements.

**Q. 2. Is it necessary to complete all the worksheets given in resources?**

**Ans.** Yes, it is necessary to complete all worksheets given in resources.

**Q. 3. Is it necessary to perform all practical tasks?**

**Ans.** Yes, it is necessary to perform all practical tasks to deliver the proper concept.

**Q. 4. How to teach the topic “other platforms” at the end of some tasks in the text books?**

**Ans.** This topic is just for general knowledge of the students. No need to make questions or perform any practical work from this topic.

**Q. 5. How to manage the activities that require typing by students which consume too much time?**

**Ans.** Teacher will type the text prior to the class and copy the file on all systems before class for the students to perform practical.

**Q. 6. How Computer Science subject will be assessed at Junior level?**

**Ans.** Computer Science is a Graded Subject at Junior level. It will be graded on the basis of Practical at each Checkpoint.

**Q. 7. How many periods are allocated for practical and theory?**

**Ans.** 1 Period is allocated for theory and 2 consecutive periods are allocated for practical work per week.

**Class IV – V**

**Q. 1. Is there any notebook for class IV-V?**

**Ans.** Yes, notebook is required for classes IV-V.

**Q. 2. What should be done on the notebooks?**

**Ans.** Teacher will make objective type questions from the headings 'Smart Tip', 'Be Safe' and 'History' from the textbooks (to be done on notebooks).

**Q. 3. From where the questions for checkpoints/term exams will be selected?**

**Ans.** Questions will be selected from worksheets, 'Hands on activities', and topics 'History', 'SmartTips', 'Be Safe' given in the textbook.

**Q. 4. How many periods are allocated for practical and theory?**

**Ans.** 1 Period for theory and 2 consecutive periods are allocated for practicals per week.

**Q. 5. How Computer Science subject will be assessed at Checkpoints?**

**Ans.** At every Checkpoint, tests (Theory+Practical) will be taken in regular teaching periods.

**Q. 6. What is the paper pattern?**

**Ans.** Class IV: Term examination will be of 50 marks. Theory: 25 marks (only objective)

Practical: 25 marks

Class V: Term examination will be of 75 marks. Theory: 40 marks (only objective)

Practical: 35 marks

**Q. 7. How to teach the topic "other platforms" at the end of some tasks in the text books?**

**Ans.** This topic is just for general knowledge of the students. No need to make questions or perform any practical from this topic.

**Q. 8. How to manage the activities that require typing by students consuming too much time?**

**Ans.** Teacher will type the text prior to the class and copy the file on all systems before class for the students to perform practical.

### **Class VI – VII**

**Ans.** Teacher will make objective/subjective type questions from the headings ‘Smart Tip’, ‘Be Safe’ and ‘History’ from the textbooks (to be done on notebooks).

**Q. 3. From where the questions for checkpoints/term exams will be selected?**

**Ans.** Questions will be selected from worksheets, evaluation sheets, ‘Hands on activities’, and topics ‘History’, ‘SmartTips’, ‘Be Safe’ given in the textbook.

**Q. 4. How many periods are allocated for practical and theory?**

**Ans.** 1 Period for theory and 2 consecutive periods are allocated for practicals per week.

**Q. 5. How Computer Science subject will be assessed at Checkpoints?**

**Ans.** At every Checkpoint, tests (Theory+Practical) will be taken in regular teaching periods.

**Q. 6. Is there any change in paper pattern?**

**Ans.** No, there is no change in paper pattern.

## FAQs related to APSACS Official Website

### **Q: Official email address?**

Ans: An official email address is provided by the Secretariat to all RDs and APS schools. Therefore all communication must be done via official email IDs.

### **Q: How can we sign in to our official email address?**

Ans: The sign in option is available on the top right side of the website homepage. Click and enter your User name & password provided by Secretariat.

### **Q: What if I forget my password?**

Ans: In this case you can contact Secretariat to reset it. It takes upto 1 day to reset an account/password.

### **Q: Can the password be changed?**

Ans: Yes. You may change your password after you login 1<sup>st</sup> time.

### **Q: Where can I find information regarding schools?**

Ans: On the homepage, under APSACS SYSTEM, click on the 3<sup>rd</sup> link - **organization > Schools** to get information of APSs of respective Regions.

### **Q: Where can I find important documents to download?**

Ans: Most recent documents/news can be found with *date of uploading* on the homepage on the bottom in News & Uploads section.

All other documents can be found under APSACS SECRETARIAT (on homepage), click on 2<sup>nd</sup> link – **Downloads** and find your required document under respective departments.

***Note:** Some documents are password protected and are only for APS school administration. Password list is provided to the RDs only.*

### **Q: Where can I send my queries/feedback?**

Ans: Parents can send their queries/feedback to the Secretariat by filling Parental feedback form. You can find it under VISITORS (on homepage), click on 4<sup>th</sup> link to open it.

### **Q: Where can I find APS activities photographs?**

Ans: On the homepage under VISITORS, click on the 5<sup>th</sup> link to find phot gallery of all APS Schools Region wise. Click on the gallery link of required school to find their photos. This gallery is linked to our official Facebook Page photo gallery.

*Note: School which have not provided their photos are not linked.*
