Revision of Class VIII Exam Policy

Weightage of marks in Examination & Check Point Tests for Class VIII has been revised from the session 2016-17 to address the following problems:

- Generally, lenient marking by teachers during the Check Point Tests was observed leading to inflated marking.
- Inflated marking facilitates weak students to get promoted to Class IX, who fail to perform up to the desired level in Send-ups.
- Schools have to arrange Extra Coaching Classes and Send-ups repeatedly for such students, in order to make them qualify for Board Exam.
- Students get maximum marks due to less content to prepare for the Check Point Test.

MEASURES TAKEN

- Weightage of Term Exam has been increased from 70% to 80% and the weightage of Check Point Test has been reduced from 30% to 20%.
- In addition to this, weightage to Second Term against the First Term has also been increased i.e 40% to the First Term Result and 60% to the Second Term Result will be taken for the Final Consolidated Result. The promotion from Class VIII to IX will be based on Final Consolidated Result.
- Second Term Exam will include identified topics from the First Term syllabus in order to prepare the students for Board Exams.
- For Class VIII result sheet has been prepared according to the new policy.

- There is no change in number of Check Points; however there is a change in the marks allotted to each Check Point Test.
- Average of the marks obtained in the Check Point Test will be taken and entered in the subsequent column meant for Average Obtained Marks in Check Points.
