<b>5. Certificates to be given after training courses</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teachers are eligible for Certificates after completing one year in their respective schools.</li><li>• The RC and the Principal will write an appraisal for the trained staff and recommend the teacher to be qualified for the certificate, keeping in view the performance of the trained teacher</li><li>• As the lists reach the Training department. Certificates will be dispatched.</li></ul>
