Hifz-e-Quran Policy

The harder the job, the more the benefit.

This is usually true for all aspects of life, whether education professional development, or one's personal life. The task of memorizing Quran is monumental, but the benefits that come with it are equally immense.

It's been proved by multiple scientific research findings that Quran memorization strengthens your memory, helps elderly people with better memory, and boosts the IQ level if you memorize at young age.

A child Psychologist in UAE, Dr. Haneen Jarrar, confirmed that Quran memorization doesn't only enhance your memory, but it helps with your learning skills as well. It improves what they call "working memory."

Currently, Hafiz-e-Quran students in APS schools are benefited under the umbrella of their respective corps. However, in order to ensure uniformity & standardization across the system in general and to facilitate transfer cases in specific, APSACS has introduced a Centralized Policy for Hifz-ul-Quran.

Basic Criteria:

The students after passing Class IV can opt for this.

Duration:

Maximum duration allowed of the completion of Hifz is 2 years.

After Hifz-ul-Quran

For APSACS Students:

After the completion of the Hifz, the students to join the regular stream in Class
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- Preference to be given to those students who secure at least 75% marks in last annual examination
- Submission of Hifz-ul-Quran verified Certificate/sanad from any institute/ Jaamia
 /Madrassa affiliated with/recognized by Wafaqul-Madaras
- Monthly tuition fee/some bare minimum amount to be submitted per month/annually by the parent to ensure that the name of his ward is not stuck off from the school's enrolment list

- No Re-admission charges/fee to be taken from the parents
- Student to be admitted according to the result of last Annual Progress Report, incase discontinues his Hifz-ul-Quran after a year or so.

For the students joining from other system

- Entrance tests to be conducted (core subjects only i.e. primary level English, Urdu and Math and Hifz-e-Quran).
- Placement of a student in class to be decided (by school administration) based on his performance in test.
- Submission of Hifz-ul-Quran verified Certificate/sanad from any institute/ Jaamia
 /Madrassa affiliated with/recognized by Wafaqul-Madaras
- Regular admission procedure to be followed by the school administration
- Passing criteria overall is 35% for these students.
