

Revision & Test Series

In order to reduce fear or anxiety of Board Examination and to assess the preparation of students:

- A comprehensive one-month plan to be developed by each subject teacher in coordination with other teachers
- FBISE paper pattern to be followed in the tests (Ratio of objective to subjective must adhere FBISE pattern)

Preferably Second half to be utilized for test (Max time: 1:30 hrs.), followed by regular teaching / revision plan in the other half. (Refer to Annex – VIII-F for details)

- Timetable to be reset during Test Series so that teaching/ revision of any subject remains unaffected / uncompromised.
- Students requiring extra coaching / remedial must be identified right from the start of the session (with the help of Result Analysis carried out by the Section Head after the Class Assessments) and catered accordingly
- Section Heads to maintain a record, of result analysis and to keep the follow-up. Result Analysis sheets will also be provided on AIS.
- Result Analysis Sheets for Senior School are uploaded on AIS, samples are attached as Annex-VIII.G & VIII G (i, ii &iii)
- Remedial Plan as attached as Annex- VIII.H
